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For Children and Youth

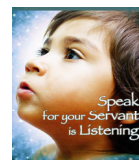

Attention All Scouting Families!

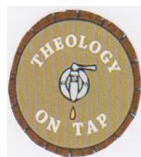

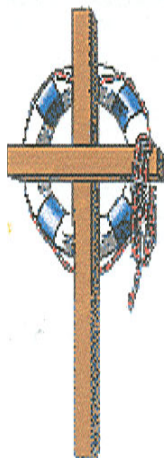

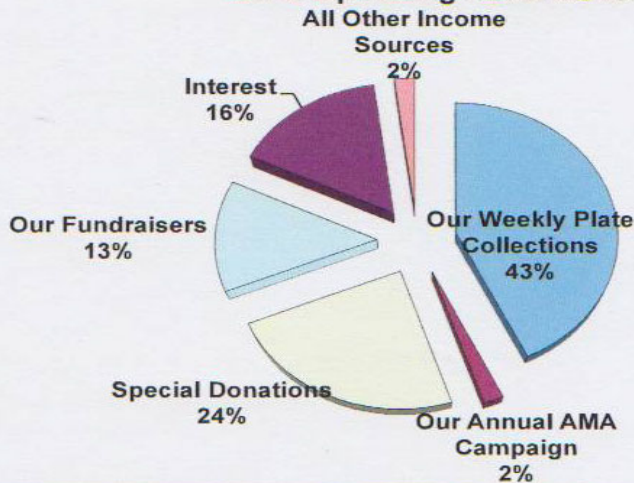

2012 Operating Revenue for 3 Months as of 11/30/11

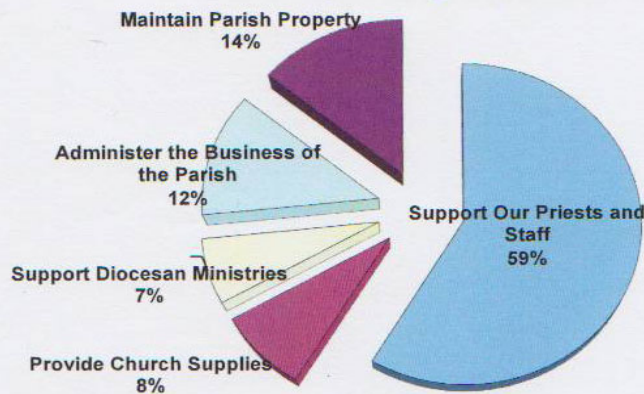
