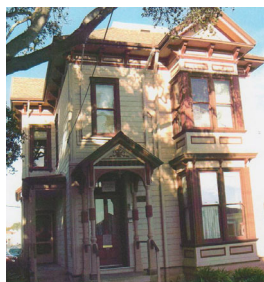

### Our Annual Ministries Appeal (AMA) 2012



Our Victorian House on 8th Street, where we have our church offices, is a historical building, so designated by the City of Pacific Grove. It is part of our town's historical treasure and, as such, is subject to strict criteria affecting repairs and renovation.

Our focus for this year's Annual Ministries Appeal is on the renovation and improvement of our

Victorian House, especially window framing repairs, plastering of walls and ceilings, and chimney and fireplace reconstruction. We have already conferred with a structural engineer and an architect and have their preliminary evaluations of the contemplated work. Now we are discussing the scope of the work with several contractors whose bids we seek; thus considerable progress has been made in planning, and we should have bids soon covering the project's cost.

Our goal for our 2012 AMA is \$75,000. Of this sum, \$28,400 goes to the Diocese, as our parish assessment, for support of its ministries- -ministries that we do not conduct in our parish, like Hispanic Outreach, Religious Vocations, and supervisorial functions for Catholic schools. The balance of \$46,600 is returned to the parish for support of our ministries, including the sites and facilities housing those ministries.

Next week on February 4 and 5, 2012, is pledge weekend. Then, we will ask your support for this important work. Registered parishioners will receive Father Paul's Pastoral letter during the week providing more detail regarding our plans. All parishioners are asked to give the AMA serious consideration and to participate. Please help us.

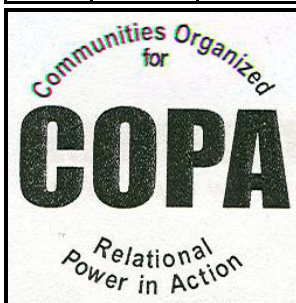
# Weekly Collections

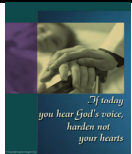
